Gym Membership Reimbursement Program

Who is eligible?

- Membertou Band Members
- Membertou Employees

How does the program work?

- 50% of Gym Memberships and Fitness Programs are reimbursed
- A valid receipt from the organization must be submitted
- **Reimbursement cheques will be distributed on Friday afternoon of each week**

What do I have to do get a gym reimbursement?

- Submit Receipt to Rebecca Scirocco-Paul, located at the Membertou Human Resources Department
- **Deadline for receipts are Thursday's of each week**

What is a valid receipt?

- Receipts must contain a stamp of the organization or must be on company letterhead. i.e. Days Inn Contract (original yellow copy will only be accepted), or a cash register receipt that has YMCA or other name at the top, or a receipt from a receipt book as long as it has the gym's stamp or contact information)
- If there is no stamp on receipt, the organization will be contacted to verify you are member of their gym or fitness program
- Gyms or fitness program facilitators may be contacted to verify validity of the membership
- **Photocopied receipts will not be accepted**
- **Receipts will not be accepted on FRIDAY'S**

PROTECT YOUR HEAD

Pouring your heart into your work is fine, but using your head at work is even better. The head is the most complex system of the human body, but it is also the most fragile and most delicate. You can generally continue living if you lose a part of your body, but not if you lose your head!

BLOOD IS DRAWN BY A LAB TECHNICIAN FROM THE REGIONAL HOSPITAL AND TAKEN THERE FOR TESTING. IF YOU HAVE AN ORDER FOR BLOOD WORK FROM YOUR FAMILY DOCTOR YOU CAN COME TO THE WELLNESS HOME INSTEAD OF GOING TO THE REGIONAL. (YOU DO NOT HAVE TO BE A PATIENT OF Dr. HALEEM'S TO USE THIS SERVICE).
