**Applications Available for Store Tobacco Quotas

All interested store owners are reminded that applications are now available for store tobacco quota. Applications can be picked up at the Tobacco Shop or at the Band Office during regular business hours.

To be eligible for a tobacco quota, the following criteria must be met:

- Store-owners must be registered Band Members of Membertou
- Store-owners must own and operate a full-time business

• Store-owners must conduct their business from either their place of residence or from a separate building for that purpose

- Store-owners must have their business name registered with the NS Registry of Joint Stocks
- Store-owners must have a Tobacco Retail Vendor Permit from the Provincial Tax Commission

Applications can be picked up at the Finance and Administration Office at the new location (47 Maillard Street) beginning on Monday, November 1st. All applications must be submitted by Friday, December 3rd 2021.

COVID-19 Close Contact Kits

Membertou is working with Nova Scotia Public Health to provide kits to individuals/families in Membertou who have been identified by public health as close contacts of COVID-19 exposure.

The kits will include: masks, gloves, thermometer, additional safety information.

If you've been contacted by public health as a close contact to exposure, you're eligible for a kit and can request one to be delivered by calling the Membertou Wellness Home.

Milk Tokens

Pregnant mothers and breastfeeding mothers with infants under the age of six months old can still receive milk tokens. However, in order to reduce traffic to the Membertou Wellness Home, tokens will be delivered to your home.

Membertou Heritage Park's Artist's Program: A Celebration of Mi'kmaw Art, Music and Culture

In the Spring of 2012, the Community of Membertou opened Heritage Park in recognition of the importance of sharing our culture and history. In the spirit of this recognition, we've launched an exciting new project to foster the growth of the next generation of Mi'kmaw creators through workshops and engagement from established artists.

Three aspiring young Mi'kmaw artists will be chosen through a nomination and selection process (details available at celebratemikmaq.com). They will embark on an exciting journey of learning and discovery, and be matched with a mentor for scheduled one-on-one training and guidance. Over the course of the program, the mentoring and creative process will be documented on video and the resulting artistic works will be featured in both virtual and physical exhibits throughout Unama'ki.

The program will also include interactive workshops presented by our selected mentors. Workshops will focus on each mentoring artist's craft, including cultural and historical references. Depending on our artist-mentor matches, workshop topics being considered include the following:

Beadwork

- Drumming
- Basket MakingPainting
- Dance
 Quillwork

Each selected trainee will receive a total bursary of \$4,500 divided into monthly payments during their participation in the program.

The trainees will be expected to apply the skills they have learned from their mentors. By the end of the program, trainees' creations will be shared in online exhibits as well as physical exhibits at Membertou Heritage Park and Membertou Trade & Convention Centre.
