- If a Used Needle is Found in the Community

 Get a non-breakable, puncture-proof container with a lid (Example: thick plastic jug);
- Place used needle inside of the container and close the lid;
- Take the container to the used-needle disposable unit, located by the back door at the Membertou Wellness Home or at the old mailbox site located on Big Noel Ekel;
- •You can throw the container with the used needle directly into the disposal unit;
- Educate your children and encourage them to tell an adult if he/she finds a needle;
- Please seek urgent medical attention if a needle stick injury occurs;
- Diabetics must bring their containers of used needles to the Membertou Wellness Home.
