### **Dishwasher & Grease Trap Attendant**

#### **Part-time Hourly**

#### **Duties and Responsibilities:**

- Responsible for regular maintenance and cleaning of the grease trap.
- Ensure that all dishware, smallware, flatware and pots & pans, are cleaned, sanitized and ready for guest consumption.
- Responsible for following the proper washing techniques.
- Ensure safe and proper use of chemicals.
- Responsible for a proper clean down of the dish pit after each shift.
- Required to take apart the dishwasher and maintain its cleanliness after each shift.
- Responsible for a heavy cleaning of the dish pit once/week.
- Assist with training new dishwashers, as required.
- Assist with receiving, unpacking and storing food and non-perishable items, when required.
- Responsible for food preparation such as washing, peeling and cutting vegetables and fruit.
- Ensure that the floors throughout the restaurant and catering kitchens are kept clean and free of debris.
- Responsible for sweeping and mopping the kitchen floor at the end of each shift.
- Sort all garbage and recyclables. Empty all kitchen garbage and recycling into the appropriate dumpster at the end of each shift.
- Responsible for locking down at the end of an evening shift, including door checks to ensure that they are closed and locked, and lights are turned off.

#### **Skills & Qualifications:**

- Must have a minimum of 1 year experience in a similar role.
- Food Handling Safety and WHMIS certifications required.
- Must be willing to work flexible hours, including days, evenings, weekends and holidays.
- Strong interpersonal and communication skills as well as a keen eye for detail are essential.
