Duties and Responsibilities:

• Ensure that all beverages are prepared in a timely manner

- Ensure that all Mise en place is fresh, clean and rotated daily such as: limes, lemons, etc.
- Responsible for setting up and restocking the bar before and after your shift.
- Responsible for ensuring that guest areas are kept clean and organized.
- General maintenance of service areas, such as washing the refrigerator, sinks, counter tops, floors and shelving associated with the bar area.
- Responsible for ensuring the liquor room is kept clean and organized.
- May be required to go on the floor to top up drinks, take drink orders, or deliver drinks for servers.
- May be required to wait on tables for food service.
- Assist with hosting duties as required, greeting customers entering the restaurant.
- All duties common to a Bartender position and/or as requested by management.
- Must be courteous and professional toward guests and co-workers.
- Promote teamwork among the serving staff and with the kitchen staff.
- Must be well groomed and appropriately dressed as per policy.
- Flexibility to work bartending shifts in the restaurant dining room and for catered banquets

Skills and Qualifications:

- Previous experience as a bartender is required.
- Ability to lift up to 25 Kg, including items such as beer cases, beer kegs and pop canisters.
- Food safety handling and responsible beverage service certifications would be an asset.
- Must be willing to work a variety of hours, based on business needs
- Preference given to Aboriginal peoples in accordance with the Aboriginal Employment Preferences Policy of the Canadian Human Rights Commission.
