Tajikeimik is seeking a communications professional to take on the role of Communications Specialist in our developing organization. Reporting to the Director of Communications and Engagement, this position will provide support and assistance to implement communications activities with First Nations communities in Nova Scotia, Indigenous organizations, and health system partners.

What you will do:-

- Assist with communications initiatives and activities, including public relations, internal communications, media relations, event planning, etc.
- Coordinate and implement communications strategies and manage projects and/or events
- Ensure Mi'kmaw culture is central to Tajikeimik communications
- · Assist in planning, and manage and monitor social media channels
- Layout and design communication materials, for example, social media posts, posters, newsletter, reports, signage, activity sheets, forms, etc.
- Research and write engaging, relevant copy for speeches, print, websites and social media
- Support Tajikeimɨk teams as a resource for their communications activities
- Assist with Tajikeimik events, including participating on planning teams, and assisting with set up and takedown
- Maintain positive, collaborative relationships with Tajikeimik teams, community Health Directors, Tribal organizations and Indigenous organizations
- Participate in team meetings and manage and prioritize your projects.
