Job Title: Groundskeeper (\$17.00/Hr)
Department: Housing & Facilities
Reports to: Director of Housing & Facilities/ Landscaper Supervisor

The Landscaping Crew is an integrated part of Housing and works under the supervision of the Landscaping Supervisor. The objective of this position is to provide day-to-day general up-keeping duties in respect to landscaping on all of Membertou's residential and commercial properties.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Spread topsoil, lay sod, plant flowers, grass, shrubs and trees and perform other duties with the construction of landscape and related structures.
- Cut grass, rake and fertilize and water lawns, weed gardens, prune shrubs and trees and perform other maintenance duties as directed by supervisor.
- Operate power mowers, tractors, chain saws, electric clippers, sod cutters, pruning saws and other landscape maintenance equipment.
- Spray and dust trees, shrubs, lawns and gardens as directed to control insects and disease.
- Perform other manual duties to clean and maintain landscaped environments.
- Abide by all Safety regulations, as required.
- Complies with Band Personnel Policy.
- Maintain positive relationships with Membertou's Internal and External Customers, ensuring transactions or information received on behalf of the Band and/or its members are kept confidential.
- Maintain and improve Membertou's Quality Management System as it relates to job related duties and/or department.
- Other department related duties as required by the Director/Landscaping Supervisor.

Qualifications:

- Prior experience with landscaping, groundskeeping or outdoor labour would be an asset.
- Willing to take training.
- Ability to work within a group and/or independently.
- Ability to lift up to 55lbs.

Work Conditions:
