



## Notice to all Potential Summer Students

The Student Term Employment Program Utilizing Partnerships (STEP UP) will start accepting applications on MAY 1<sup>st</sup>, 2026.

Applications for summer employment will be open to **Membertou band members** who were full-time post-secondary students or Grade 10-12 High School students residing in Nova Scotia during the 2025/26 school-year.

Students who take initiative and find their own placement will receive **the maximum extra weeks** of employment in their grade category. See chart below for more details.

Please be advised that students who do not take initiative or fail to list specific interests on their applications will be limited to four weeks of employment.

To ensure a full placement, we encourage you to be proactive in detailing your qualifications and preferences.

### University/College:

- June 22 to August 28 (10 weeks) @\$18.00 per hour
- June 22 to August 14 (8 weeks) @\$18.00 per hour
- June 22 to July 17 (4 weeks) @\$18.00 per hour

### Grade 11 & 12:

- July 6 to August 28 (8 weeks) @\$16.75 per hour
- July 6 to August 14 (6 weeks) @\$16.75 per hour
- July 6 to July 31 (4 weeks) @\$16.75 per hour

### Grade 10:

- July 6 to August 14 (6 weeks) @\$16.75 per hour
- July 6 to July 31 (4 weeks) @\$16.75 per hour

**Please note** that all student applicants must have a Social Insurance Number (SIN) and a bank account for payroll purposes.

- Post-Secondary students are reminded they must submit their marks to the Post Secondary Navigator and High School students must pass 4 out of their 8 courses before being considered for employment.
