Job Title: Dishwasher
Position: Part-Time Hourly
Department: Membertou Trade & Convention Centre (MTCC)

The Membertou Trade and Convention Centre seeking dependable and motivated individual(s) to perform the role of Dishwasher. Day, evening, and weekend shifts. Previous dishwashing experience not required, training will be provided.

Duties & Responsibilities:

- Ensure that all dishware, smallware, flatware and pots & pans, are cleaned, sanitized and ready for guest consumption.
- Responsible for following the proper washing techniques.
- Ensure safe and proper use of chemicals.
- Responsible for a proper clean down of the dish pit after each shift.
- Required to take apart the dishwasher and maintain its cleanliness after each shift.
- Required to change the water in the dishwasher as required throughout each shift.
- Ensure that the floors throughout the restaurant and catering kitchens are kept clean and free of debris throughout each shift.
- Required to immediately wipe up any spills in the back of the house and the front of the house and to use proper “wet floor” signage when applicable.
- Responsible for sweeping and mopping the kitchen floor at the end of each shift.
- Sort all garbage and recyclables. Empty all kitchen garbage and recycle it into the appropriate dumpster at the end of each shift.
- Responsible for locking down at the end of an evening shift, including door checks to ensure that they are closed and locked, and lights are turned off.
- Comply with Band policies.
- All duties common to a Dishwasher and any related duties that may be assigned by management.

Skills & Qualifications:

- No experience required, training will be provided.
- Must be willing to work flexible hours, including days, evenings, weekends and holidays.
- Must have ability to lift to 25 Kg.
- Strong interpersonal and communication skills.
